raindrops falling down.

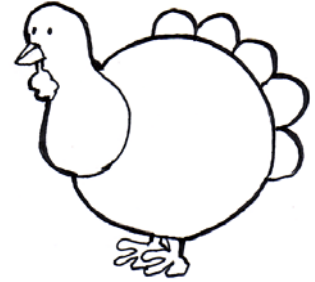
Can you see the splashing water? All the
